



WOODS RESIDENCE

The house was built in 1993 but suffered from water damage due to improperly installed flashing, house wrap, and windows. A complete DuPont Weatherization System was installed for protection against the Northwest's wettest weather. The entire garage was moved and turned 90 degrees to optimize views of the home. The height of the house also included challenges: requiring extensive scaffolding to reach difficult areas to support a safe work area.



CUSTOMIZED FEATURES

All new Kolbe & Kolbe exterior doors were installed at all locations. Along with new decks and glass railings.

BEATIFUL EXTERIOR UPGRADES

A slate gray standing seam metal roof, bright red reverse board and baton siding, and new vinyl windows were installed for even better protection as well as modernizing the look of the house.

DESIGN FIXTURES & LIGHTING

Cultured stone on the first floor was added to break up the height of the house and enhance architectural details.
